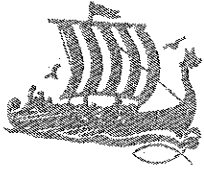

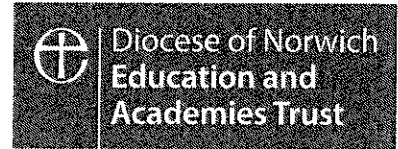

The quality of the applications was the best to date and as a result, we have offered a number of additional roles and responsibilities.

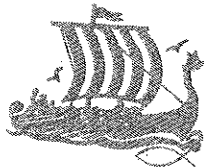
Gracie-Mai, Harvey, Ruby and Sam will be School Ambassadors.

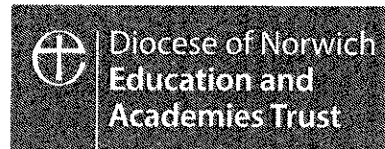

### **School Uniform**

Please consult our uniform policy, listed below, when making purchases over the summer holidays. School uniform is compulsory and parents will be contacted if their child is not wearing the appropriate uniform after the summer break.

Our school uniform:

- Grey or black skirts, trousers or tailored shorts
- Green gingham summer dress
- White polo shirt/blouse/shirt
- Green sweatshirt, fleece, cardigan or jumper
- Appropriate black shoes. (These must be completely black)

We advise parents to provide flat shoes to avoid any accidents that could occur. School shoes should be worn all year and no open-toe sandals should be worn. It is important that each item of clothing is clearly marked with your child's name. All lost uniform can then be returned. No hooded tops are allowed to be worn as uniform.

### **Jewellery**

Jewellery should not be worn for school, with the possible exception of wrist watches or earrings with a rounded stud. Coloured nail varnish, including acrylic and gel nails, should not be worn by pupils.

### **Indoor PE Kit**

All children will need:

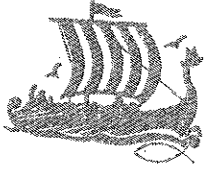
- Navy /Black shorts
- House Coloured t-shirt

### **Outside PE Kit will also require:**

- Navy/Black or House coloured Football/Hockey Socks
- Trainers (These may get muddy)
- Tracksuit or/and sports sweatshirt

These need to be brought in to school on a Monday and kept in a named bag. PE kits will be sent home on a Friday to be washed. As children will be taking part in sport and PE outside during the colder months, they will need warm clothing. Please ensure your child has access to their kit at all times.



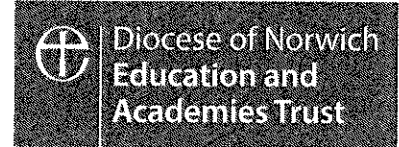
