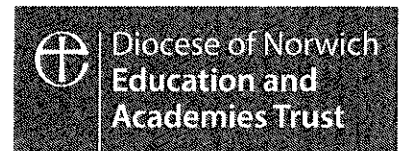

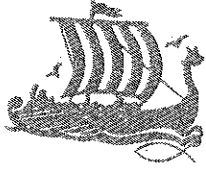
EYFS visit to Norwich Castle

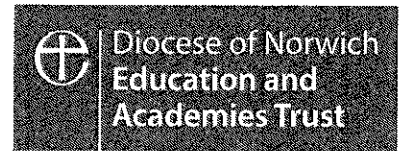

Hands on Heritage

On Thursday 24th and Friday 25th May 2018, Year 6 pupils travelled back in time to an Anglo-Saxon settlement located in the depths of Tunstall Forest, Suffolk.

The children's experience was focused on the Prehistoric to Saxon periods. They learnt about the life and skills of the time through practical workshops and experiments. This was a fantastic opportunity for our children to learn about their heritage in an active, hands-on and fun environment, as well as teaching them teamwork skills and giving them the chance to try new experiences.

Their visit enabled them to experience a range of planned and well-supervised workshops including: woodworking, fire-lighting, whittling and butter-knife making and spinning and weaving.

Whilst on site, the children cooked their own meals and baked their own bread in the open-air kitchen. Meals were based on Prehistoric or Roman recipes using fresh, and where possible, organic ingredients and cooked using authentic techniques.

The children had an incredible experience which they will never forget.

Young Carers Afternoon Tea

At the start of this half-term, young carers and their families were invited to attend an Afternoon Tea Event at the school.

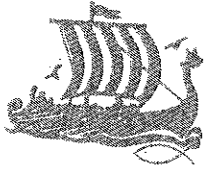
Thrigby Hall Trip

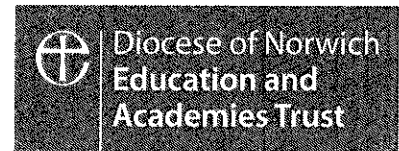

Our school website now has an Online Safety Guidance section; this can be found under Parent Information, within the Information section.

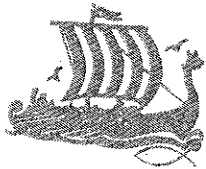
Class Photographs

School reports are being prepared and will be sent home with your child. If you require an additional copy, please inform the School Office as soon as possible.



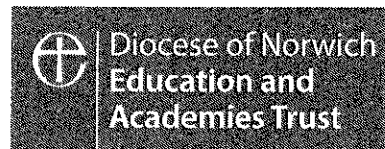
