



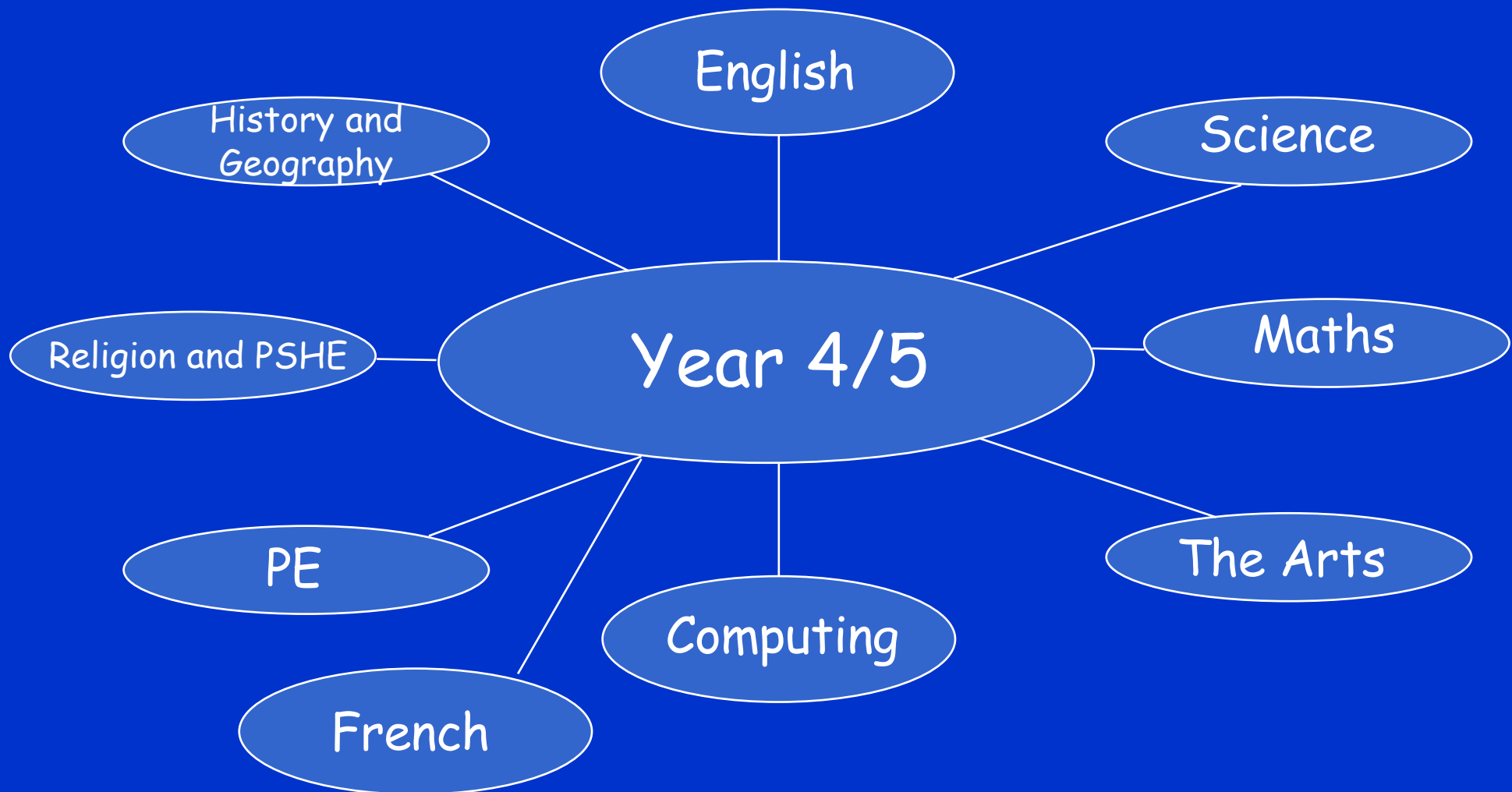

Reading

- Every morning, we will check Reading Records for reading and parent/carer signatures and record whether or not your child has read at home.
- Please ensure that your child reads for a minimum of five nights (10 minutes per night).
- Please encourage your child to practice learning the key words from their text and ask them relevant questions about the books that they are reading.

English

- This Term we are reading: Stormbreaker by Anthony Horowitz
- Spellings - tested every Thursday and new spellings to be given out on Fridays.
- SPaG Focus for this half term: Conjunctions.
