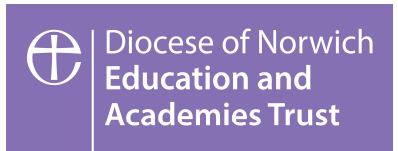

As the clubs are very popular, we are asking parents to sign up for the half term. In the event that a club is oversubscribed, we will draw names from a hat and those that are not chosen will be added to the waiting list and will be able to take part after February half term. All places will be confirmed to you by before Christmas. After school clubs remain at £1 per session and you will need to pay via ParentMail in advance for the 6 weeks. If for any reason the school needs to cancel a session we will refund you. After-school clubs are free for children in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. Please speak to the school office if you are uncertain about your child's eligibility.

Clubs begin immediately after school and finish promptly at 4:15pm. Your child/children should be collected from the main school office, by an adult.
