As the clubs are very popular, we are asking parents to sign up for the half term. In the event that a club is oversubscribed, we will draw names from a hat and those that are not chosen will be added to the waiting list and will be able to take part after May half term. All places will be confirmed to you before the Easter holidays. After school clubs remain at £1 per session and you will need to pay via ParentMail in advance for the first 4 weeks. If for any reason the school needs to cancel a session, we will refund you. After-school clubs are free for children in receipt of Pupil Premium funding.
