



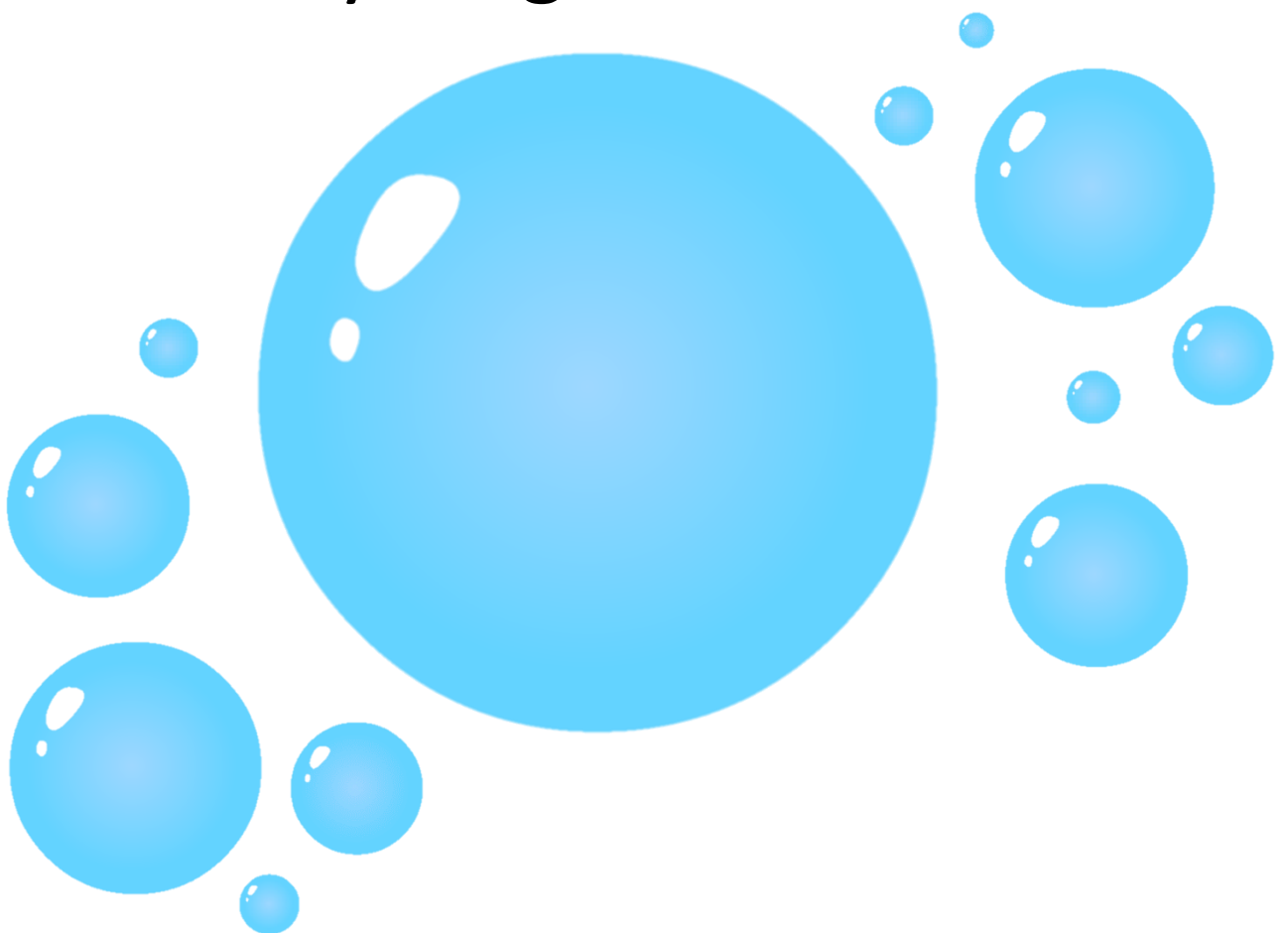





## What is Bubble School?


We have decided to call this Bubble School because you will all be in small groups called bubbles! You will do everything with your bubble - learn, play and eat.



Each bubble will have a space inside and outside the school to call their own.




For now, you will not be able to mix with children from other bubbles.

Bubbles cannot be formed in space due to the lack of air pressure!




## In My Classroom


Every bubble will have their own classroom. You will spend most of the day in your classroom and your teacher will make it very clear what you can and can't do. Here are a few tips to get you started...




Every child will have their own desk and their own equipment.




You will have the same sort of lessons as you did before - English, Maths etc.




You will not be able to get up and walk around the room anymore.

## My Equipment


You will still need equipment in school, but we will just need to be careful that we keep everything to ourselves as much as possible.




You will keep everything on, or under, your desk all day.




Your coat will go on the back of your chair.

You will need to bring a water bottle that is cleaned every day.




Your teacher will give you all the books and stationery that you need.




Some fish use bubbles to create their nests!

## Break Time and Lunch


At Bubble School you will spend more time outside than before. There will be three breaks during the day for you to enjoy.




You will eat your school or home packed lunch in the classroom.




Your teacher or TA will stay with you during break and lunch.




You will only be able to play with children in your bubble.

You will have to ask if you need to go to the toilet.




The world record for the most people inside a bubble is 19!




## Going to the Toilet

Each bubble will have their own toilets to use. We all need to make sure that we remember the rules about good hygiene.



Your teacher will tell you which toilet to use.



You will be able to go to the toilet whenever you need it - but you must ask an adult first.



You must not go into your toilet area if other children are in there.



You will need to wash your hands for 20 seconds, just like before.
