Physical Development
Participate in team games to develop turn taking and accuracy. Promote team work and the ability to win and lose in a sporting manner

Language and Communication
Show and tell -continue to share items which are precious to you and hold a conversation when engaged in back-and-forth exchanges with their teacher and peers
Use helicopter stories to share stories we have composed ourselves acting out with the class
Be confident to share your ideas with the class

Literacy
Spell words by identifying sounds in them and representing the sounds with a letter or letters.
Write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others and include simple punctuation, such as capital letters and full stops.
Read words consistently applying phonics knowledge
Read aloud simple sentences and books that are consistent with their phonic knowledge, including some common exception words.

Mathematical Development
Develop a deep understanding of numbers to 10
Revisit 'more than' and 'fewer than' and join in with counting sequences
Begin to identify missing parts for numbers within 5
Understand that two equal groups can be called a 'double' and connect this to finger patterns
Instantly recall addition facts
Create repeating patterns
Count beyond 20 Sort odd and even numbers

Understanding The World
Understand the importance of water to all life and how we all need it to survive
Discuss the need to save water and why it is so precious
Look at how the sea is being polluted and how our use of plastic is important to protecting our rivers and seas.
Identify ways to help save water and recycle and reduce our plastic
Discuss and identify countries with no running water. What is a drought?
Look at ways we can save water through everyday

Expressive Art and Design
Creating imagined landscapes with mixed media such as creating a sea /water collage.
Large scale printing to create a landscape
Paintings inspired by music
Land art inspired by famous artists Andy Goldsworthy, Robert Smithson, Nancy Holt. Snail spirals using playdough and clay
Embed the different aspects of music, i.e. beat, pitch through clapping and using instruments
